DR CHEE KOK YOON

Senior consultant neuropsychiatrist with many years of experience specialising in psychiatry and neuropsychiatry. He is currently the head of Neuropsychiatry Program at the MOH, Malaysia. Dr. Chee graduated from the University of Malaya in 2007 with a Master Degree in Psychological Medicine; and later pursued the field of neuropsychiatry at the Melbourne Neuropsychiatry Unit, Royal Melbourne Hospital, Australia in 2011 and the Lishman Unit, Bethlem Royal Hospital, UK in 2017. He is recently awarded the Distinguished Fellow by the Pacific Rim College of Psychiatrists. Dr. Chee has published more than 60 scientific papers in regional and international journals on schizophrenia, depression and bipolar mood disorders. He is also the reviewer for the first National ECT Guideline in Malaysia.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR DR MADIHAH BINTI MOHAMAD SHUKRI She graduated in 1999 with degree in Psychology from the IIUM and master degree in Educational Psychology from UPM in 2001. Later, she pursued with PhD degree in Health Psychology from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Leeds in 2012. Presently, she serves as a lecturer in Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Development UMT. She was appointed as Associate Editor of Journal of Sustainable Science and Management (JSSM), Journal of Business and Social Development (JSBD) and the content journal editor for UMT Journal of Undergraduate Research.
